ORDER

It appears from the Order bearing Code No. ERC/7-106(18).4.1/2010/3815(1) dated 29.04.2010 issued by the Regional Director, Eastern Regional Committee, National Council for Teacher Education, that in exercise of the powers vested under Clause (a) of Sub - section 3 of Section 14 of National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee has granted recognition to Reapara Primary Teachers' Training Institute, Vill. & P.O. Reapara, P.S. Nandigram, Dist. Purba Medinipur, PIN-721 650 for conducting Primary Teachers' Training (Diploma-in-Education) Course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50(fifty) students.

The West Bengal Board of Primary Education, being the Examining Body, appointed vide Gazette Notification of the Order dated 23RD October, 2008 issued by the Principal Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, School Education Department, Primary Branch, grants affiliation from the academic session 2010–2011 in terms of said Order to Reapara Primary Teachers' Training Institute, Vill. & P.O. Reapara, P.S. Nandigram, Dist. Purba Medinipur, PIN-721 650 for conducting ETE (D. Ed.) Course of Elementary level of Two-Year duration with an annual intake of 50(fifty) trainees. Conditions as laid down in recognition Order of NCTE should be strictly followed. Special emphasis is to be given regarding age, marks obtained in the H.S. Examination or its equivalent by the trainees and current reservation scheduled at the time of admission.

Fees payable to the Examining Body by the Institute and its students would be intimated by this Office in due course of time.
